Steps to Access Safe Sport E-Learning on



For Self-Registration Page Users

Step 1 [Create an account via the Self-Registration Page]

Create an account with SportSG-ED via <u>Self Registration Link</u> (only if you have NOT logged in SportSG-ED before; if you have logged in before – refer to Page 3)

Ensure that you have **read** the information on the Self-Registration Page as this is just a **temporary account** for you to access Safe Sport modules.

Use your **FULL NAME** as in NRIC/FIN when you register as the Name will appear in the certificate.

Your **Username / User ID** will be the email used for registration.

Ensure you key in the correct Organisation Code

Your account will only be active for **ONE month** from the time you registered. Do ensure the following:
